

Second Writings Ma`asei (Acts 2:32-3:22)

Acts 2:32-47

32 "Elohim has raised up this יהושע, of which we are all witnesses.

33 "Therefore, having been exalted to the right hand of Elohim, and having received from the Father the promise of the Set-apart Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear.

34 "For Dawid did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself said, יהוה said to my Master, "Sit at My right hand,

35 until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet." '

36 Therefore let all the house of Yisra'el know for certain that Elohim has made this יהושע, whom you impaled, both Master and Messiah.

37 And having heard this, they were pierced to the heart, and said to Kěpha and the rest of the emissaries, "Men, brothers, what shall we do?"

38 And Kěpha said to them, "Repent, and let each one of you be immersed in the Name of יהושע Messiah for the forgiveness of sins. And you shall receive the gift of the Set-apart Spirit.

39 For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are far off, as many as יהוה our Elohim shall call.

40 And with many other words he earnestly witnessed and urged them, saying, "Be saved from this crooked generation."

41 Then those, indeed, who gladly received his word, were immersed. And on that day about three thousand beings were added to them.

42 And they were continuing steadfastly in the teaching of the emissaries, and in the fellowship, and in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers.

43 And fear came upon every being, and many wonders and signs were being done through the emissaries.

44 And all those who believed were together, and had all in common,

45 and sold their possessions and property, and divided them among all, as anyone might have need.

46 And day by day, continuing with one mind in the Set-apart Place, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart,

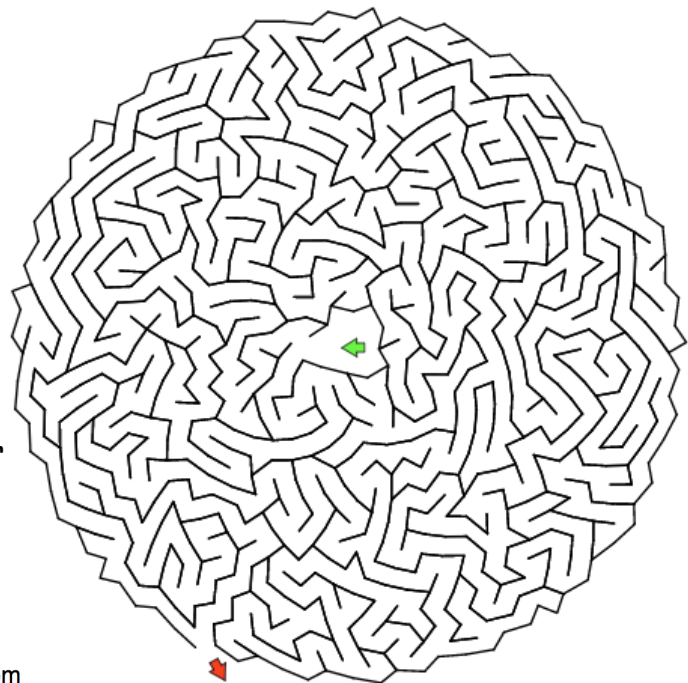
47 praising Elohim and having favour with all the people. And the Master added to the assembly those who were being saved, day by day.

Acts 3:1-22

1 And Kěpha and Yoħanan were going up to the Set-apart Place at the hour of prayer, the ninth hour.

2 And a certain man, lame from his birth, was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the Set-apart Place which is called Yaphah, to ask alms from those entering into the Set-apart Place,

3 who, seeing Kěpha and Yoḥanan about to go into the Set-apart Place, asked for alms.
4 And Kěpha, with Yoḥanan, looking steadfastly at him, said, "Look at us."
5 And he gave heed to them, expecting to receive whatever from them.
6 But Kěpha said, "I do not have silver and gold, but what I do possess, this I give you: In the Name of יהושע Messiah of Natsareth, rise up and walk."
7 And taking him by the right hand he lifted him up, and immediately his feet and ankle bones were made firm.
8 And leaping up, he stood and walked, and went in with them into the Set-apart Place, walking and leaping and praising Elohim.
9 And all the people saw him walking and praising Elohim.
10 And they recognised him, that it was he who sat begging alms at the Lovely Gate of the Set-apart Place. And they were filled with wonder and amazement at what befell him.
11 And as the lame man who was healed was clinging to Kěpha and Yoḥanan, all the people ran together to them in the porch which is called Shelomoh's, greatly amazed.
12 And seeing it, Kěpha responded to the people, "Men of Yisra'ěl, why do you marvel at this? Or why look so intently at us, as though by our own power or reverence we have made him walk?
13 "The Elohim of Abraham, and of Yitshaq, and of Ya'aqob, the Elohim of our fathers, esteemed His Servant יהושע, whom you delivered up and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he had decided to release Him.
14 "But you denied the Set-apart and Righteous One, and asked that a man, a murderer, be granted you.
15 "But you killed the Prince of life, whom Elohim raised from the dead, of which we are witnesses.
16 "And by the belief in His Name, this one whom you see and know, His Name made strong, and the belief which comes through Him has given him this perfect healing before all of you.
17 "And now, brothers, I know that you did it in ignorance, as your rulers did too.
18 "But this is how Elohim has filled what He had announced beforehand through the mouth of all the prophets, that His Messiah was to suffer.
19 "Repent therefore and turn back, for the blotting out of your sins, in order that times of refreshing might come from the presence of the Master,
20 and that He sends יהושע Messiah, pre-appointed for you,
21 whom heaven needs to receive until the times of restoration of all matters, of which Elohim spoke through the mouth of all His set-apart prophets since of old.
22 "For Mosheh truly said to the fathers, יהוה' your Elohim shall raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brothers. Him you shall hear according to all matters, whatever He says to you.

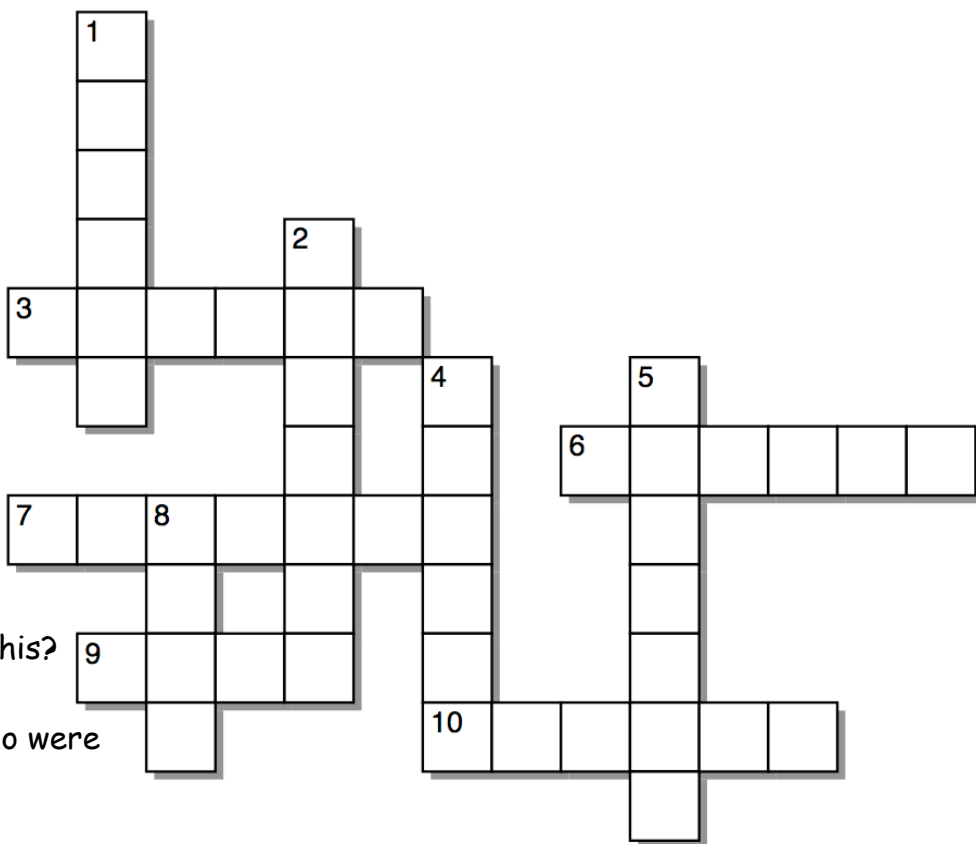
