

Second Writings Ma`asei (Acts 9:27-10:21)

Acts 9:27-43

27 But Barnaba took him and brought him to the emissaries, and told them how he had seen the Master on the way, and that He had spoken to him, and how he was speaking boldly at Dammeseq in the Name of יהושע.

28 And he was with them at Yerushalayim, coming in and going out,

29 and speaking boldly in the Name of the Master יהושע and disputed with the Hellenists, but they undertook to kill him.

30 And when the brothers learned of this, they brought him down to Caesarea and sent him out to Tarsos.

31 Then indeed the assemblies throughout all Yehudah, and Galil, and Shomeron had peace and were built up, and walking in the fear of יהוה and in the encouragement of the Set-apart Spirit, they were being increased.

32 And it came to be, as Kěpha was passing through all places, that he also came down to the set-apart ones who were dwelling at Lod.

33 And there he found a certain man named Aeneas, who had been bedridden for eight years, being paralytic.

34 And Kěpha said to him, "Aeneas, יהושע the Messiah heals you! Rise up and make your bed." And immediately he rose up.

35 And all those dwelling at Lod and Sharon saw him and did turn to the Master.

36 And in Yapho there was a certain taught one named Tabitha, which means Dorkas. This woman was filled with good works and kind deeds which she did.

37 And it came to be in those days that she became sick and died. And having washed her, they laid her in an upper room.

38 And Lod being near to Yapho, and the taught ones having heard that Kěpha was there, they sent two men to him, urging him not to delay in coming to them.

39 And having risen up, Kěpha went with them. And when he arrived, they brought him to the upper room. And all the widows stood beside him weeping, showing the inner garments and outer garments which Dorkas had made while she was with them.

40 But Kěpha sent them all out, and knelt down and prayed. And turning to the body he said, "Tabitha, arise." And she opened her eyes, and seeing Kěpha, she sat up.

41 And giving her his hand, he lifted her up. And calling the set-apart ones and widows, he presented her alive.

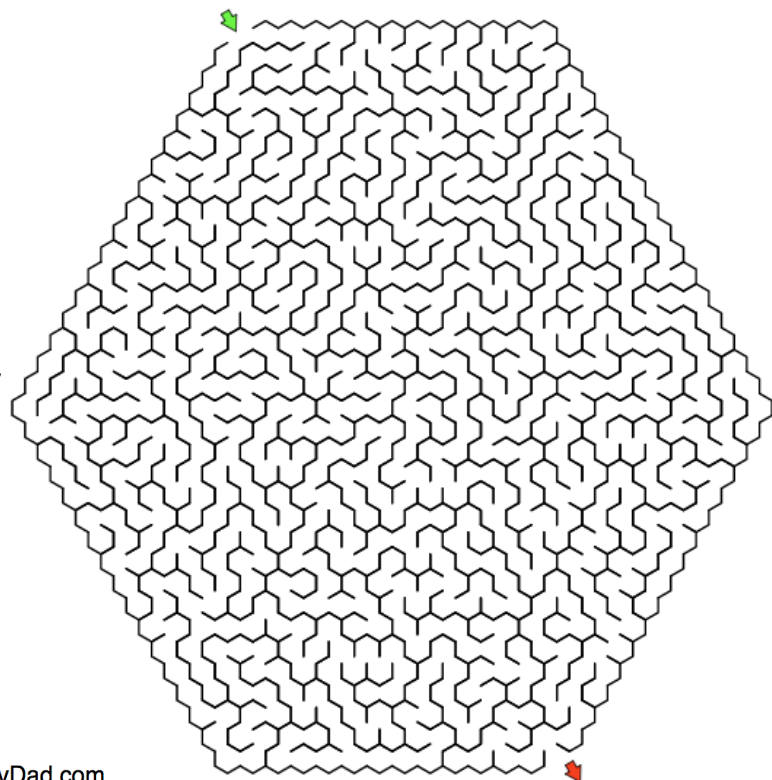
42 And it became known throughout all Yapho, and many believed on the Master.

43 And it came to be that he stayed for many days in Yapho with Shim'on, a leather-tanner.

Acts 10:1-21

1 Now there was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a captain of what was called

the Italian Regiment,
2 dedicated, and fearing Elohim with all his household, doing many kind deeds to the people, and praying to Elohim always.
3 He clearly saw in a vision, about the ninth hour of the day, a messenger of Elohim coming to him, and saying to him, "Cornelius!"
4 And looking intently at him, and becoming afraid, he said, "What is it, master?" And he said to him, "Your prayers and your kind deeds have come up for a remembrance before Elohim.
5 "And now send men to Yapho, and send for Shim'on who is also called Kěpha.
6 "He is staying with Shim'on, a leather-tanner, whose house is by the sea."
7 And when the messenger who spoke to him went away, Cornelius called two of his household servants, and a dedicated soldier from among those who waited on him continually.
8 And having explained to them all, he sent them to Yapho.
9 And on the next day, as they were on their way and approaching the city, Kěpha went up on the house-top to pray, about the sixth hour.
10 And he became hungry and wished to eat. But while they were preparing, he fell into a trance,
11 and he saw the heaven opened and a certain vessel like a great sheet bound at the four corners, descending to him and let down to the earth,
12 in which were all kinds of four-footed beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping creatures, and the birds of the heaven.
13 And a voice came to him, "Rise up, Kěpha, slay and eat."
14 But Kěpha said, "Not at all, Master! Because I have never eaten whatever is common or unclean."
15 And a voice came to him again the second time, "What Elohim has cleansed you do not consider common."
16 And this took place three times, and the vessel was taken back to the heaven.
17 And while Kěpha was doubting within himself about what the vision might mean, look, the men who had been sent from Cornelius, having asked for the house of Shim'on, stood at the gate,
18 and calling out, they enquired whether Shim'on, also known as Kěpha, was staying there.
19 And as Kěpha was thinking about the vision, the Spirit said to him, "See, three men seek you.
20 But rise up, go down and go with them, not doubting at all, for I have sent them.
21 So Kěpha went down to the men who had been sent to him from Cornelius, and said, "Look, I am the one you seek. Why have you come?"

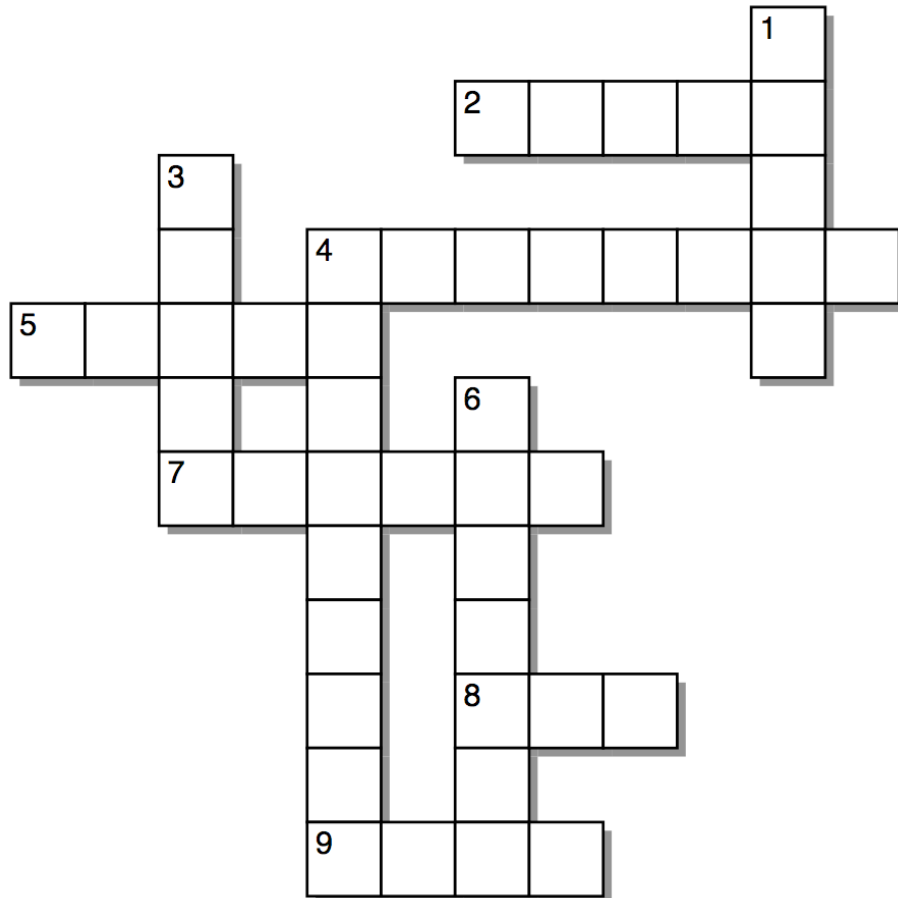
