Pilipiyim/Qolasim
(Philippians 4:1-Colossians 1:17)

Philippians 4:1-23

1 So then, my brothers, beloved and longed-for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Master, beloved.

2 I appeal to Euodia and I appeal to Suntucho to be of the same mind in the Master.

3 And I also ask you, true companion, help these women who laboured with me in the Good News, with Qlemes also, and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the Book of Life.

4 Rejoice in יהוה always, again I say, rejoice!

5 Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Master is near.

6 Do not worry at all, but in every matter, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to Elohim.

7 And the peace of Elohim, which surpasses all understanding, shall guard your hearts and minds through Messiah יהושע.

8 For the rest, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is righteous, whatever is clean, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good report, if there is any uprightness and if there is any praise - think on these.

9 And what you have learned and received and heard and saw in me, practise these, and the Elohim of peace shall be with you.

10 And I rejoiced in יהוה greatly that now at last your concern for me has revived again - though you were concerned, but had no chance.

11 Not that I speak concerning need, for I have learned to be content in whatever state I am.

12 I know what it is to be humbled, and I know what it is to have in excess. In any and every situation I have learned both to be filled, and to be hungry, both to have in excess, and to be in need.

13 I have strength to do all, through Messiah who empowers me.

14 Yet you did well in sharing in my pressure.

15 And you know too, Philippians, that in the beginning of the Good News, when I went out from Makedonia, no assembly shared with me concerning giving and receiving, except you only,

16 because, even in Thessalonike you sent to my need, once and twice.

17 Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that is multiplying to your account.

18 Indeed I have all and more than enough. I have been filled, having received from Epaphroditos what you sent, a sweet-smelling fragrance, an acceptable offering, well-pleasing to Elohim.

19 And my Elohim shall fill all your need according to His riches in esteem by Messiah יהושע.

20 And to our Elohim and Father be esteem forever and ever. Aměn.

21 Greet every set-apart one in Messiah יהושע. The brothers with me greet you.

22 All the set-apart ones greet you, but most of all those of Caesar's household.

23 The favour of our Master יהושע Messiah be with you all. Amĕn.

Colossians 1:1-17

1 Sha'ul, an emissary of יהושע Messiah by the desire of Elohim, and Timotiyos our brother,

2 to the set-apart ones in Colosse, and true brothers in Messiah: Favour to you and peace from Elohim our Father and the Master יהושע Messiah.

3 We give thanks to the Elohim and Father of our Master יהושע Messiah, praying always for you,

4 having heard of your belief in Messiah יהושע and of your love for all the set-apart ones, 5 because of the expectation that is laid up for you in the heavens, of which you heard before in the word of the truth of the Good News,

6 which has come to you, as also in all the world it is bearing fruit and growing, as also among you, since the day you heard and knew the favour of Elohim in truth,

7 as you also learned from Epaphras, our beloved fellow servant, who is a true servant of Messiah on your behalf,

8 who also declared to us your love in the Spirit.

9 That is also why we, from the day we heard, have not ceased praying for you, and asking that you be filled with the knowledge of His desire in all wisdom and spiritual understanding,

10 to walk worthily of the Master, pleasing all, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of Elohim,

11 being empowered with all power, according to the might of His esteem, for all endurance and patience with joy,

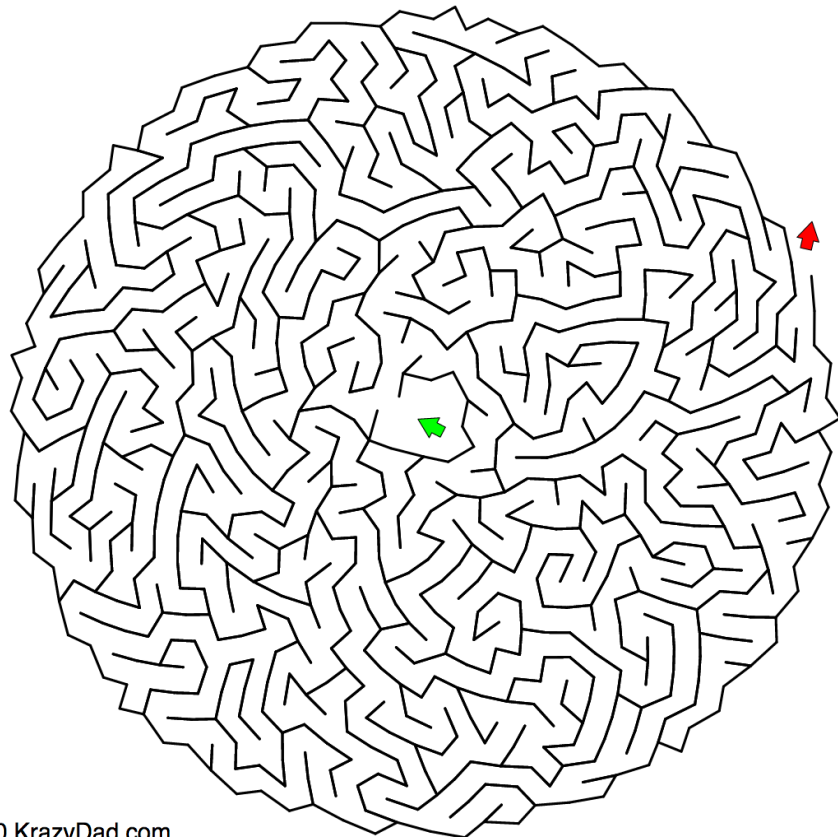
12 giving thanks to the Father who has made us fit to share in the inheritance of the set-apart ones in the light,

13 who has delivered us from the authority of darkness and transferred us into the reign of the Son of His love, 14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins,

15 who is the likeness of the invisible Elohim, the first-born of all creation.

16 Because in Him were created all that are in the heavens and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or rulerships or principalities or authorities - all have been created through Him and for Him.

17 And He is before all, and in Him all hold together.

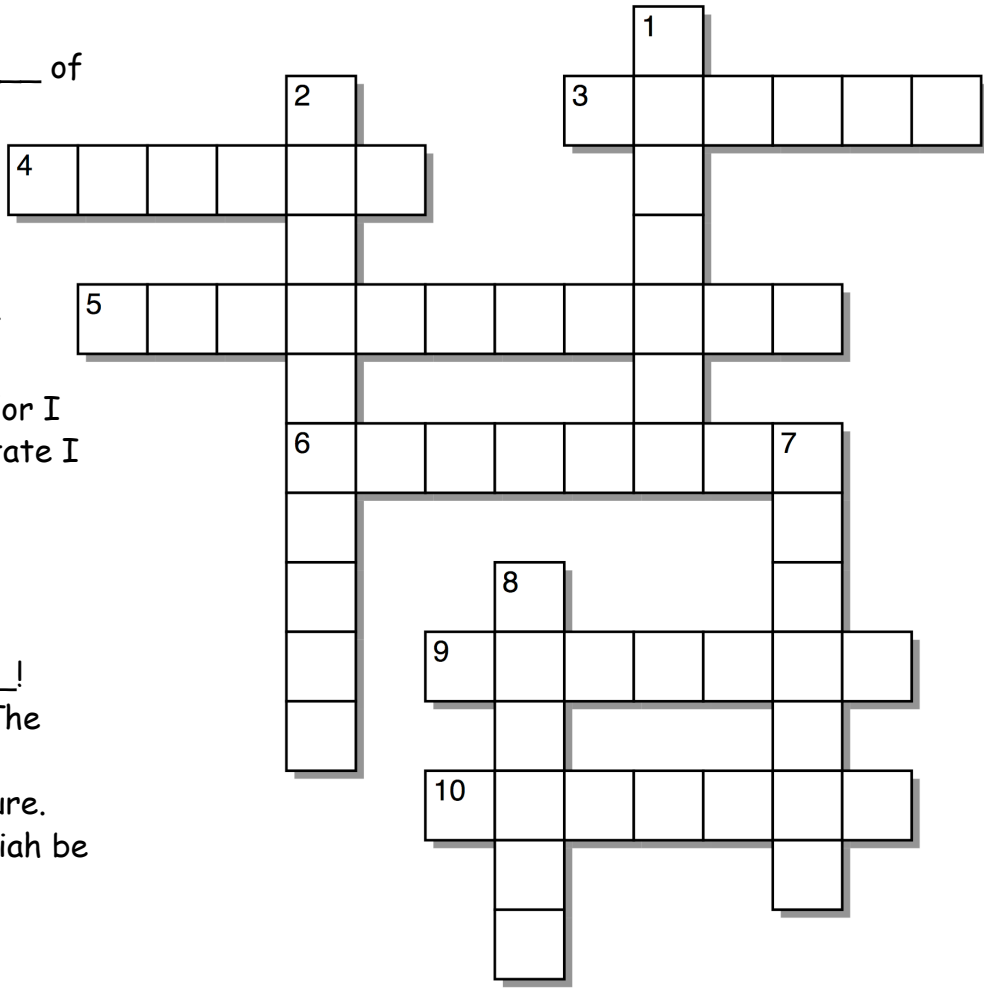
