

Purim - Hidden Names throughout the Book of Esther
Compiled from "His Name is Jesus" by Yacov Rambsel

Esther 1:3 *that* in the third year of his reign he made a feast for all his officials and servants -- the powers of Persia and Media, the nobles, and the princes of the provinces *being* before him – (equidistant letter sequencing, interval of 8 – משיח /Mashiach/Messiah)

בשנת שלוש למלכו עשה משתה לכל־שריו ועבדיו תיל
פרס ומדי הפרתמים ושרי המדינות לפניו:

Esther 1:20 "When the king's decree which he will make is proclaimed throughout all his empire (for it is great), all wives will honor their husbands, both great and small." (יהוה written backwards for יהוה is turning back human wisdom – equidistant letter sequencing, every 3rd letter)

ונשמע פתגם המלך אשר־יעשה בכל־מלכותו כי רבה
היא וכל־הנשים יתנו יקר לבעליהן למגדול ועד־קטן:

Esther 5:4 So Esther answered, "If it pleases the king, let the king and Haman come today to the banquet that I have prepared for him." (equidistant letter sequencing for יהוה, interval of 4, for He will also be at the banquet!)

ותאמר אסתר אם־על־המלך טוב יבוא המלך והמן היום
אל־המשתה אשר־עשיתי לו:

Esther 5:13 "Yet all this avails me nothing, so long as I see Mordecai the Jew sitting at the king's gate." (final letters of 4 consecutive words, His Name is spelled backwards as יהוה is overruling Haman's gladness and turning back his counsel)

וכל־היא איננו שוה לי בכל־עת אשר אני ראה את־מרדכי
היהודי יושב בשער המלך:

Esther 7:7 Then the king arose in his wrath from the banquet of wine *and went* into the palace garden; but Haman stood before Queen Esther, pleading for his life, for he saw that **evil was determined against him** by the king. (equidistant letter sequence for יהוה, every 4th letter)

והמלך קם בחמתו ממשתה היין אל־גנת הביתן והמן
עמד לבקש על־נפשו מאסתר המלכה כי ראה כי־כלתה
אליו הרעה מאת המלך:

Esther 4:17 So Mordecai went his way and did according to all that Esther commanded him. (backward equidistant letter sequencing for Yeshua/ ישוע, every 8th letter)

וַיַּעֲבֹר מֹרְדֵכָי וַיַּעַשׂ כְּכֹל אֲשֶׁר-צִוְתָהּ עָלָיו אֶסְתֵּר:

Esther 5:2 So it was, when the king saw Queen Esther standing in the court, *that* she found favor in his sight, and the king held out to Esther the golden scepter that *was* in his hand. Then Esther went near and touched the top of the scepter. (backward equidistant letter sequencing for Israel/ ישראל, every 3rd letter)

וַיְהִי כִּרְאוֹת הַמֶּלֶךְ אֶת-אֶסְתֵּר הַמַּלְכָּה עֹמֶדֶת בַּחֲצַר נְשָׂאָה
חֵן בְּעֵינָיו וַיּוֹשֵׁט הַמֶּלֶךְ לְאֶסְתֵּר אֶת-שֵׁרְבִיט הַזָּהָב אֲשֶׁר
בְּיָדוֹ וַתִּקְרַב אֶסְתֵּר וַתִּגַּע בְּרֹאשׁ הַשֵּׁרְבִיט:

Esther 4:2 He went as far as the front of the king's gate, for no one *might* enter the king's gate clothed with sackcloth. ³ And in every province where the king's command and decree arrived, *there was* great mourning among the Jews, with fasting, weeping, and wailing; and many lay in sackcloth and ashes. (equidistant letter sequencing for El Shaddai/ אל שדי, every 7th letter)

וַיָּבֹא עַד לְפָנַי שַׁעַר-הַמֶּלֶךְ כִּי אֵין לְבֹא אֶל-שַׁעַר הַמֶּלֶךְ
בְּלְבוּשׁ שָׂק: ³ וּבְכָל-מְדִינָה וּמְדִינָה מְקוֹם אֲשֶׁר דִּבְרַת-הַמֶּלֶךְ
וַדָּתוֹ מִגִּיעַ אֲבָל גְּדוֹל לַיהוּדִים וְצוּם וּבְכִי וּמִסַּפֵּד שָׂק
וְאִפְרָ יֵצַע לְרַבִּים:

Esther 9:3 And all the officials of the provinces, the satraps, the governors, and all those doing the king's work, helped the Jews, because the fear of Mordecai fell upon them. ⁴ For Mordecai *was* great in the king's palace, and his fame spread throughout all the provinces; for this man Mordecai became increasingly prominent. ⁵ Thus the Jews defeated all their enemies with the stroke of the sword, with slaughter and destruction, and did what they pleased with those who hated them. (spelled backwards equidistant letter sequencing for Yeshua/ ישוע, every 24th letter)

הַיְהוּדִים בְּכָל-אִיבֵיהֶם מִפְּתֵ-חָרֵב וְהָרַג וְאִבְדָּן וַיַּעֲשׂוּ
בְּשֵׁנָאֵיהֶם כְּרָצוֹנָם:

Esther 9:22 as the days on which the Jews had rest from their enemies, as the month which was turned from sorrow to joy for them, and from mourning to a holiday; that they should make them days of feasting and joy, of sending presents to one another and gifts to the poor. (backward equidistant letter sequencing for **Bread of Messiah**/ **להם משיח**, every 8th letter)

Esther 7:5 So King Ahasuerus answered and said to Queen Esther, "Who is he, and where is he, who would dare presume in his heart to do such a thing?" (equidistant letter sequencing for I am who I am [Shemot 3:14]/ **אהיה**, every 3rd letter)

וַיֹּאמֶר הַמֶּלֶךְ אַחַשְׁוֵרוּשׁ וַיֹּאמֶר לְאַסְתֵּר הַמַּלְכָּה מִי הוּא
זֶה וְאֵי־זֶה הוּא אֲשֶׁר־מָלְאוּ לְבוֹ לַעֲשׂוֹת כֵּן:
