

Portion: VaYishlach (And He Sent)
Berēshith (Genesis 34:26-35:29)

Genesis 34:26-31

26 And they killed Hamor and Shekem his son with the edge of the sword, and took Dinah from Shekem's house, and went out.

27 The sons of Ya'aqob came upon the slain, and plundered the city, because they had defiled their sister.

28 They took their flocks and their herds, and their donkeys, and that which was in the city and that which was in the field,

29 and all their wealth. And all their little ones and their wives they took captive, and they plundered all that was in the houses.

30 And Ya'aqob said to Shim'on and Lēwi, "You have troubled me by making me a stench among the inhabitants of the land, among the Kena'anites and the Perizzites. And I am few in number, they shall gather themselves against me and shall strike me, and I shall be destroyed, my household and I."

31 But they said, "Should he treat our sister like a whore?"

Genesis 35:1-29

1 And Elohim said to Ya'aqob, "Arise, go up to Bēyth Ĕl and dwell there. And make a slaughter-place there to Ĕl who appeared to you when you fled from the face of Ĕsaw your brother."

2 And Ya'aqob said to his household and to all who were with him, "Put away the foreign mighty ones that are among you, and cleanse yourselves, and change your garments.

3 And let us arise and go up to Bēyth Ĕl, and let me make there a slaughter-place to Ĕl, who answered me in the day of my distress, and has been with me in the way which I have gone.

4 So they gave Ya'aqob all the foreign mighty ones which were in their hands, and all their earrings which were in their ears. And Ya'aqob hid them under the terebinth tree which was near Shekem.

5 And they departed, and the fear of Elohim was upon the cities that were all around them, and they did not pursue the sons of Ya'aqob.

6 And Ya'aqob came to Luz, that is Bēyth Ĕl, which is in the land of Kena'an, he and all the people who were with him.

7 And he built there a slaughter-place and called the place El Bēyth Ĕl, because there Elohim appeared to him when he fled from the face of his brother.

8 And Deborah, Ribqah's nurse, died, and she was buried below Bēyth Ĕl under the terebinth tree. So the name of it was called Allon Bakuth.

9 And Elohim appeared to Ya'aqob again, when he came from Paddan Aram, and blessed him.

10 And Elohim said to him, "Your name is Ya'aqob, your name is no longer called Ya'aqob, but Yisra'el is your name." So He called his name Yisra'el.

11 And Elohim said to him, "I am Eil Shaddai. Be fruitful and increase, a nation and a company of nations shall be from you, and sovereigns come from your body.

12 And the land which I gave Abraham and Yitshaq I give to you. And to your seed after you I give this land.

13 And Elohim went up from him in the place where He had spoken with him.

14 And Ya'aqob set up a standing column in the place where He had spoken with him, a monument of stone. And he poured a drink offering on it, and he poured oil on it.

15 And Ya'aqob called the name of the place where Elohim spoke with him, Bëyth Eil.

16 Then they set out from Bëyth Eil. And it came to be, when there was but a little distance to go to Ephrath, that Raḥel began to give birth, and had great difficulty giving birth.

17 And it came to be, as she was having great difficulty giving birth, that the midwife said to her, "Do not fear, for it is another son for you."

18 And it came to be, as her life was going out - for she died - that she called his name Ben-Oni. But his father called him Binyamin.

19 So Raḥel died and was buried on the way to Ephrath, that is Bëyth Leḥem.

20 And Ya'aqob set a standing column on her burial-place, which is the monument of Raḥel's burial-place to this day.

21 And Yisra'el set out and pitched his tent beyond the tower of Eder.

22 And it came to be, when Yisra'el dwelt in that land, that Re'ubën went and lay with Bilhah his father's concubine. And Yisra'el heard about it. Now the sons of Ya'aqob were twelve:

23 the sons of Lë'ah were Re'ubën, Ya'aqob's first-born, and Shim'on, and Lëwi, and Yehuḏah, and Yissaskar, and Zebulun;

24 the sons of Raḥel were Yosëph and Binyamin;

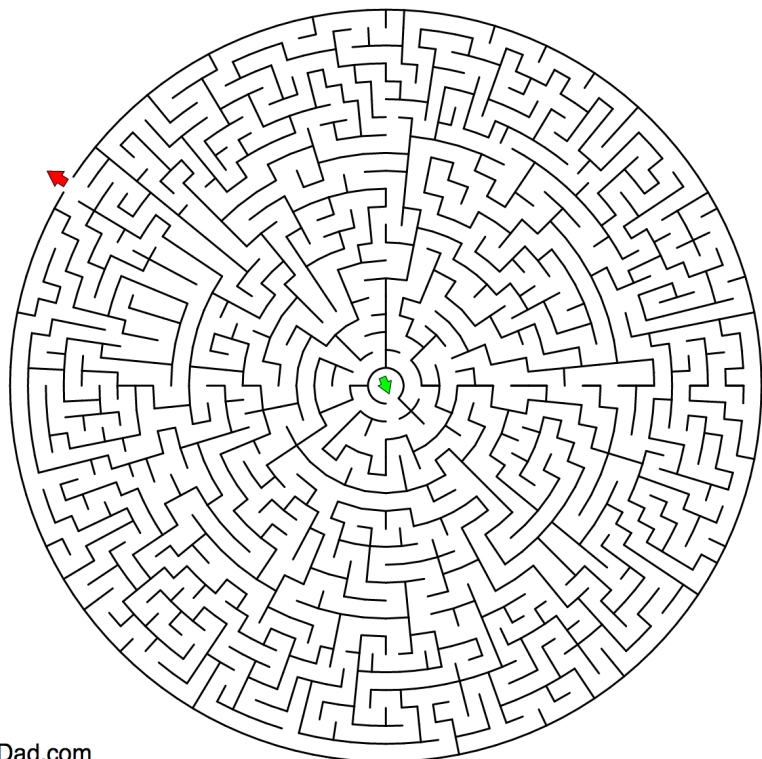
25 the sons of Bilhah, Raḥel's female servant, were Dan and Naphtali;

26 and the sons of Zilpah, Lë'ah's female servant, were Gaḏ and Ashër. These were the sons of Ya'aqob who were born to him in Paddan Aram.

27 And Ya'aqob came to his father Yitshaq at Mamrë, or Qiryath Arba, that is Hebron, where Abraham and Yitshaq had dwelt.

28 And the days of Yitshaq were one hundred and eighty years.

29 So Yitshaq breathed his last and died, and was gathered to his people, aged and satisfied of days. And his sons Ešaw and Ya'aqob buried him.

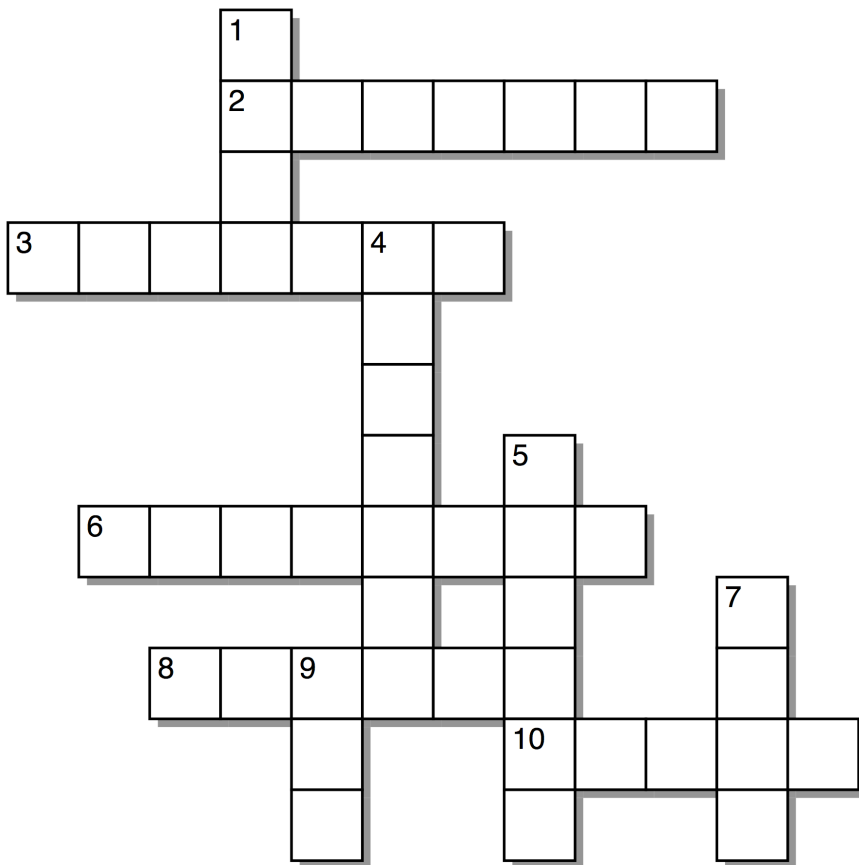
