

## Second Writings Yohanan (John 11:32-12:13)

John 11:32-57

32 Miryam, therefore, when she came where יהושע was, and saw Him, she fell down at His feet, saying to Him, "Master, if You had been here, my brother would not have died."

33 יהושע, therefore, when He saw her weeping, and the Yehudim who came with her weeping, He groaned in the spirit and was troubled,

34 and said, "Where have you laid him?" They said to Him, "Master, come and see."

35 יהושע wept.

36 The Yehudim therefore said, "See how He loved him!"

37 And some of them said, "Was this One, who opened the eyes of the blind, not also able to prevent this one from dying?"

38 יהושע, therefore, again groaning in Himself, came to the tomb. Now it was a cave, and a stone lay against it.

39 יהושע said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of him who had died, said to Him, "Master, already he smells, for it is four days."

40 יהושע said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you believe, you shall see the esteem of Elohim?"

41 So they took away the stone where the dead man was laid. And יהושע lifted up His eyes and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me.

42 And I know that You always hear Me, but because of the crowd standing by I said this, in order that they believe that You sent Me.

43 And when He had said this, He cried with a loud voice, "El'azar, come out!"

44 And he who died came out bound feet and hands with wrappings, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. יהושע said to them, "Loosen him, and let him go."

45 Therefore many of the Yehudim who had come to Miryam, and had seen what יהושע did, believed in Him.

46 But some of them went away to the Pharisees and told them what יהושע did.

47 So the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered a council and said, "What shall we do? Because this Man does many signs.

48 If we let Him alone like this, they all shall believe in Him, and the Romans shall come and take away from us both our place and nation.

49 And one of them, Qayapha, being high priest that year, said to them, "You know naught,

50 neither do you consider that it is better for us that one man die for the people than that the entire nation should perish."

51 But he did not say this from himself, but being high priest that year he prophesied that יהושע was about to die for the nation,

52 and not for the nation only, but to gather together into one the children of Elohim who were scattered abroad.

53 So from that day on they plotted to kill Him.

54 יהושע therefore no longer went openly among the Yehudim, but went from there into the country near the wilderness, to a city called Ephrayim, and remained there with His taught ones.

55 Now the Pěsah of the Yehudim was near, and many went from the country up to Yerushalayim before the Pěsah, to set themselves apart.

56 And so they were seeking יהושע, and spoke among one another, standing in the Set-apart Place, "What do you think? Is He not coming to the festival at all?"

57 And both the chief priests and the Pharisees had given a command, that if anyone knew where He was, he should disclose it, in order for them to seize Him.

John 12:1-13

1 Accordingly יהושע, six days before the Pěsah, came to Běyth Anyah, where El'azar was, who had died, whom He raised from the dead.

2 So they made Him a supper there, and Martha served, while El'azar was one of those who sat at the table with Him.

3 Then Miryam took a pound of costly perfume of nard, anointed the feet of יהושע, and wiped His feet with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume.

4 Then one of His taught ones, Yehudah from Qerioth, son of Shim'on, who was about to deliver Him up, said,

5 Why was this perfume not sold for three hundred denarii and given to the poor?

6 And he said this, not because he was concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and he used to take what was put in it.

7 יהושע then said, "Let her alone, she has kept this for the day of My burial.

8 For the poor you have with you always, but Me you do not have always.

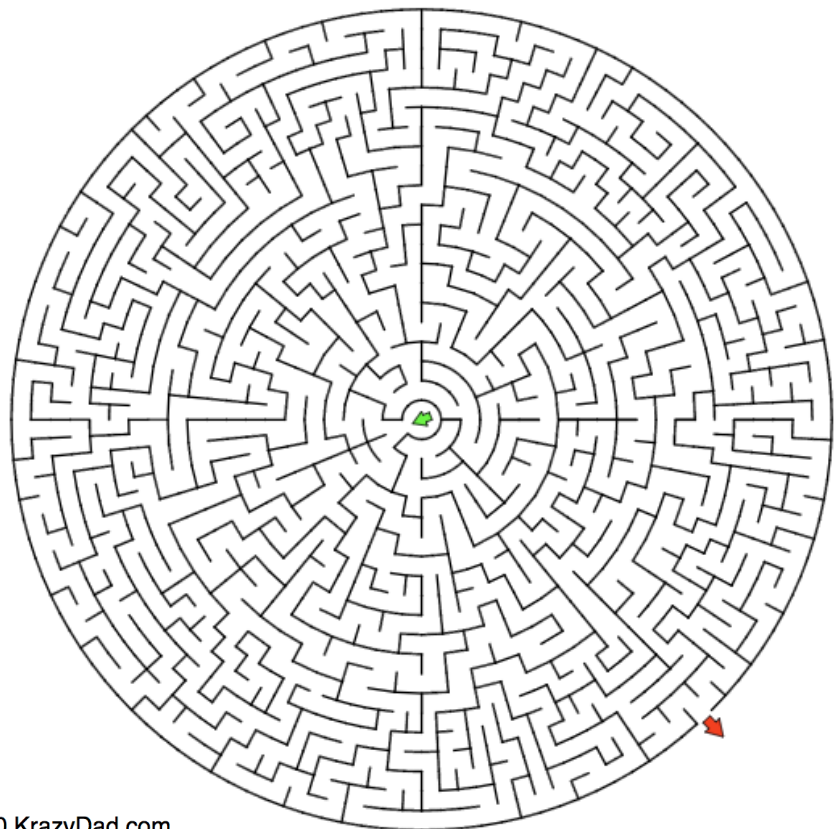
9 Then a great crowd of the Yehudim learned that He was there. And they came, not on account of יהושע only, but also to see El'azar, whom He had raised from the dead.

10 And the chief priests resolved to kill El'azar as well,

11 because on account of him many of the Yehudim went away and believed in יהושע.

12 On the next day a great crowd who had come to the festival, when they heard that יהושע was coming to Yerushalayim,

13 took the branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and were crying out, "Hoshia-na! Blessed is He who is coming in the Name of יהוה, the Sovereign of Yisra'el!"

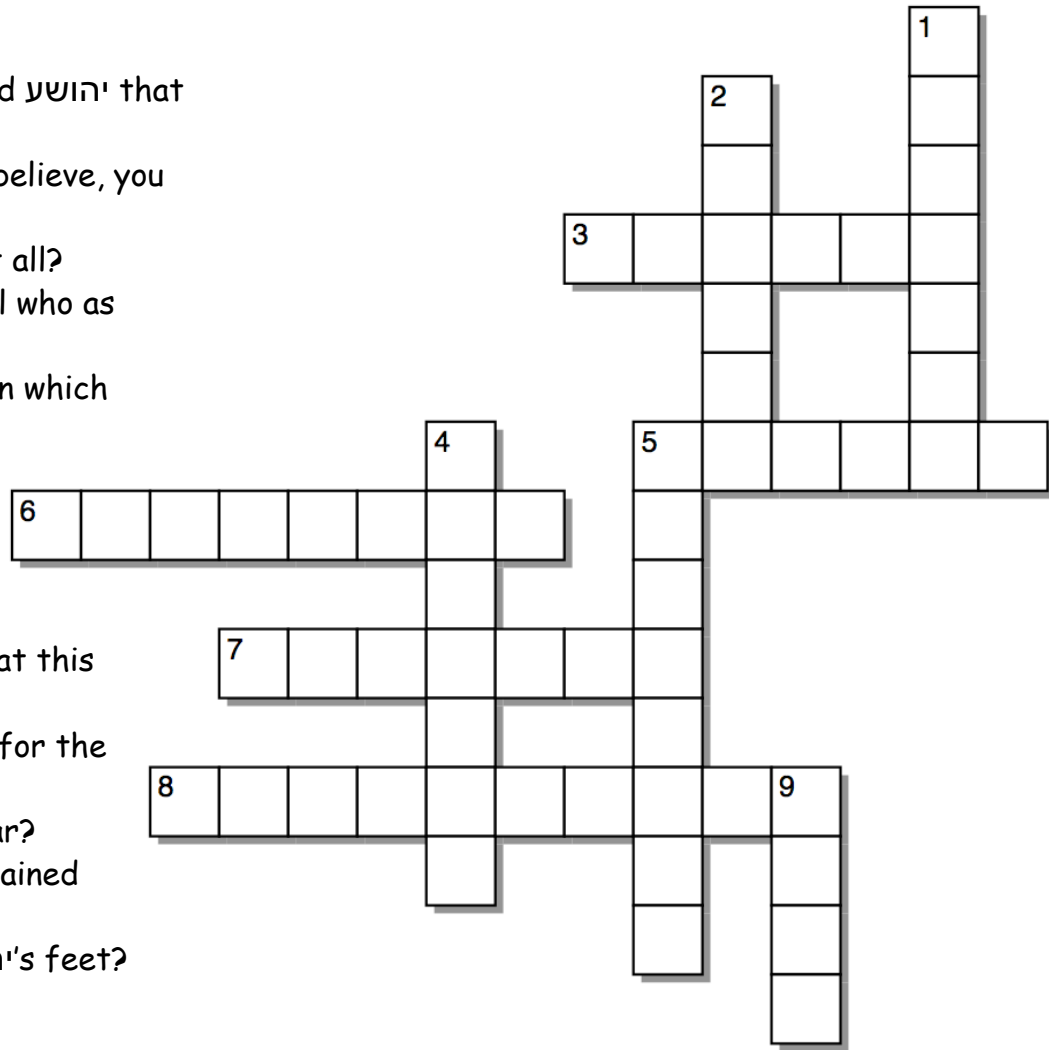
