

## Second Writings Yohanan (John 20:6-21:11)

John 20:6-31

- 6 Then Shim'on Kěpha came, following him, and went into the tomb. And he saw the linen wrappings lying,  
7 and the cloth which had been on His head, not lying with the linen wrappings, but folded up in a place by itself.  
8 So, then, the other taught one, who came to the tomb first, also went in. And he saw and believed.  
9 For they did not yet know the Scripture, that He has to rise again from the dead.  
10 Therefore the taught ones went away again, by themselves.  
11 But Miryam was standing outside by the tomb weeping. Then as she wept, she stooped down to the tomb,  
12 and saw two messengers in white sitting, one at the head and the other at the feet, where the body of יהושע had been laid.  
13 And they said to her, "Woman, why do you weep?" She said to them, "Because they took away my Master, and I do not know where they laid Him."  
14 And having said this, she turned around and saw יהושע standing, but she did not know that it was יהושע.  
15 יהושע said to her, "Woman, why do you weep? Whom do you seek?" Thinking He was the gardener, she said to Him, "Master, if You have carried Him away, say to me where You put Him, and I shall take Him away."  
16 יהושע said to her, "Miryam!" She turned and said to Him, "Rabboni!" (which means Teacher).  
17 יהושע said to her, "Do not hold on to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father. But go to My brothers and say to them, 'I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My Elohim and your Elohim.' "  
18 Miryam from Maḡdala came announcing to the taught ones that she had seen the Master, and that He had told her this.  
19 When therefore it was evening on that day, day one of the week, and when the doors were shut where the taught ones met, for fear of the Yehudim, יהושע came and stood in the midst, and said to them, "Peace to you."  
20 And having said this, He showed them His hands and His side. The taught ones therefore rejoiced when they saw the Master.  
21 Then יהושע said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."  
22 And having said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Set-apart Spirit.  
23 If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they have been retained.  
24 But Toma, called the Twin, one of the twelve, was not with them when יהושע came,

25 so the other taught ones said to him, "We have seen the Master." But he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the mark of the nails, and put my finger into the imprint of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I shall by no means believe."

26 And after eight days His taught ones were again inside, and T'oma with them. יהושע came, the doors having been shut, and He stood in the midst, and said, "Peace to you!"

27 Then He said to T'oma, "Bring your finger here, and see My hands. And bring your hand and put it into My side - and do not be unbelieving, but believing."

28 And T'oma answered and said to Him, "My Master and my Elohim!"

29 יהושע said to him, "T'oma, because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

30 There were indeed many other signs that יהושע did in the presence of His taught ones, which are not written in this book,

31 but these have been written so that you believe that יהושע is the Messiah, the Son of Elohim, and that, believing, you might possess life in His Name.

### John 21:1-11

1 After this יהושע manifested Himself again to the taught ones at the Sea of Kinnereth, and He manifested this way:

2 Shim'on Kěpha, and T'oma called the Twin, and Nethan'ěl of Qanah in Galil, the sons of Zabdai, and two others of His taught ones were together.

3 Shim'on Kěpha said to them, "I am going to fish." They said to him, "We are also coming with you." They went out and immediately entered into the boat. And that night they caught none at all.

4 But when it became early morning, יהושע stood on the beach. However, the taught ones did not know that it was יהושע.

5 Then יהושע said to them, "Children, have you any food?" They answered Him, "No."

6 And He said to them, "Throw the net on the right side of the boat, and you shall find." So they threw, and they were no longer able to draw it in because of the large number of fish.

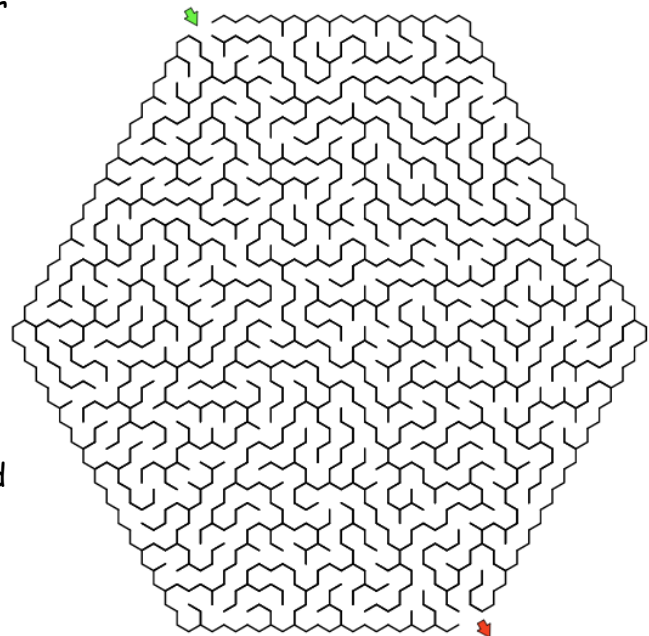
7 That taught one whom יהושע loved then said to Kěpha, "It is the Master!" Then Shim'on Kěpha, hearing that it was the Master, put on his outer garment - for he was stripped - and plunged into the sea.

8 And the other taught ones came in the little boat - for they were not far from land, but about two hundred cubits - dragging the net with fish.

9 So when they had come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid on it, and bread.

10 יהושע said to them, "Bring some of the fish which you have now caught."

11 Shim'on Kěpha went up and dragged the net to land, filled with one hundred and fifty-three big fishes. And though there were so many, the net was not broken.

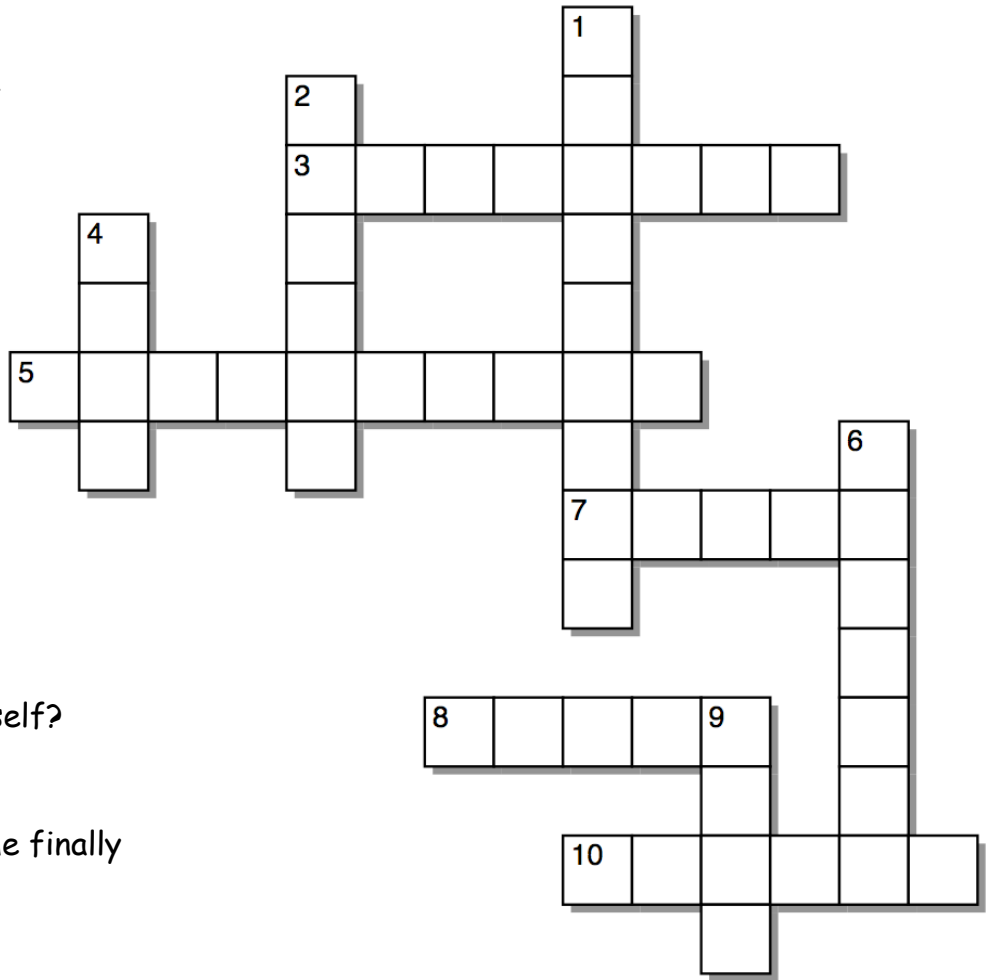
