Yohanan (John 4:43-5:25)

- 43 And after the two days He left there and went to Galil.
- 44 For יהושע Himself witnessed that a prophet is without appreciation in his own country.
- 45 Therefore when He came to Galil, the Galileans received Him, having seen all that He had done in Yerushalayim at the festival, for they also went to the festival.
- 46 Then יהושע came again to Qanah of Galil where He had made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman whose son was sick at Kephar Nahum.
- 47 When he heard that יהושע had come from Yehudah into Galil, he went to Him and was asking Him to come down and heal his son, for he was about to die.
- 48 יהושע then said to him, "If you people do not see signs and wonders, you do not believe at all."
- 49 The nobleman said to Him, "Master, come down before my child dies!"
- 50 יהושע said to him, "Go, your son lives." And the man believed the word that יהושע spoke to him, and went.
- 51 And while he was going down, his servants met him and reported, saying, "Your son lives!"
- 52 He then asked from them the hour in which he became better, and they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the inflammation left him."
- 53 Then the father knew that it was at the same hour in which יהושע said to him, "Your son lives." And he himself believed, and all his household.
- 54 Again this was the second sign יהושע did, when He had come from Yehudah into Galil.

- 1 After this there was a festival of the Yehudim, and יהושע went up to Yerushalayim.
- 2 And in Yerushalayim at the Sheep Gate there is a pool, which is called in Hebrew, Bēyth Zatha, having five porches.
- 3 In these were lying a great number of those who were sick, blind, crippled, paralysed, waiting for the stirring of the water.
- 4 For a messenger was going down at a certain time into the pool and was stirring the water. Whoever stepped in first, then, after the stirring of the water, became well of whatever disease he had.
- 5 And a certain man was there who had a sickness thirty-eight years.
- 6 When יהושע saw him lying there, and knowing that he already had been a long time, He said to him, "Do you wish to become well?"
- 7 The sick man answered Him, "Master, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is stirred, but while I am coming, another steps down before me."
- 8 יהושע said to him, "Rise, take up your bed and walk."
- 9 And immediately the man became well, and he took up his bed and was walking. Now it was Sabbath on that day.

10 The Yehudim therefore said to him who had been healed, "It is the Sabbath, it is not right for you to take up the bed."

11 He answered them, "He who made me well said to me, 'Take up your bed and walk.' "

12 Therefore they asked him, "Who is the Man who said to you, 'Take up your bed and walk?'"

13 But the one who was healed did not know who it was, for יהושע had moved away, a crowd being in that place.

14 Afterward יהושע found him in the Set-apart Place, and said to him, "See, you have been made well. Sin no more, so that no worse matter befalls you."

15 The man went away, and told the Yehudim that it was יהושע who made him well.

16 And because of this the Yehudim persecuted יהושע, and were seeking to kill Him, because He was doing these healings on the Sabbath.

17 But יהושע answered them, "My Father works until now, and I work."

18 Because of this, then, the Yehudim were seeking all the more to kill Him, 'because not only was He breaking the Sabbath, but He also called Elohim His own Father, making Himself equal with Elohim.'

19 Therefore יהושע responded and said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son is able to do none at all by Himself, but only that which He sees the Father doing, because whatever He does, the Son also likewise does.

20 "For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all that He Himself does. And greater works than these He is going to show Him, in order that you marvel.

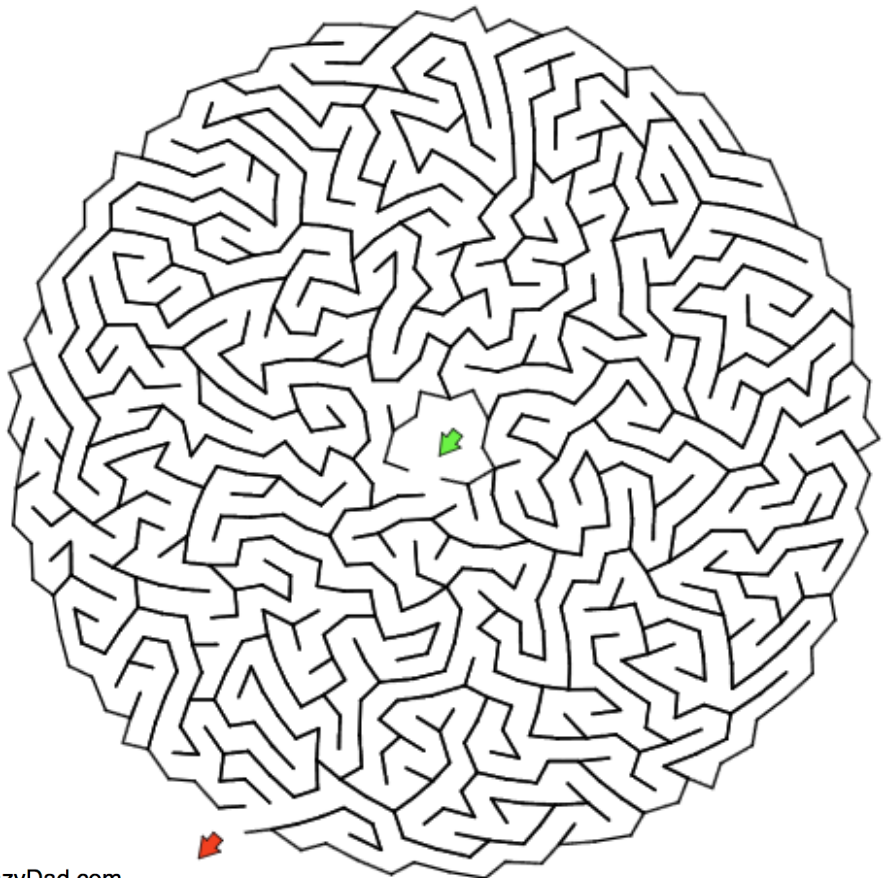
21 "For as the Father raises the dead and makes alive, even so the Son makes alive whom He wishes.

22 "For the Father judges no one, but has given all the judgment to the Son,

23 that all should value the Son even as they value the Father. He who does not value the Son does not value the Father who sent Him.

24 "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me possesses everlasting life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.

25 "Truly, truly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of Elohim. And those having heard shall live.

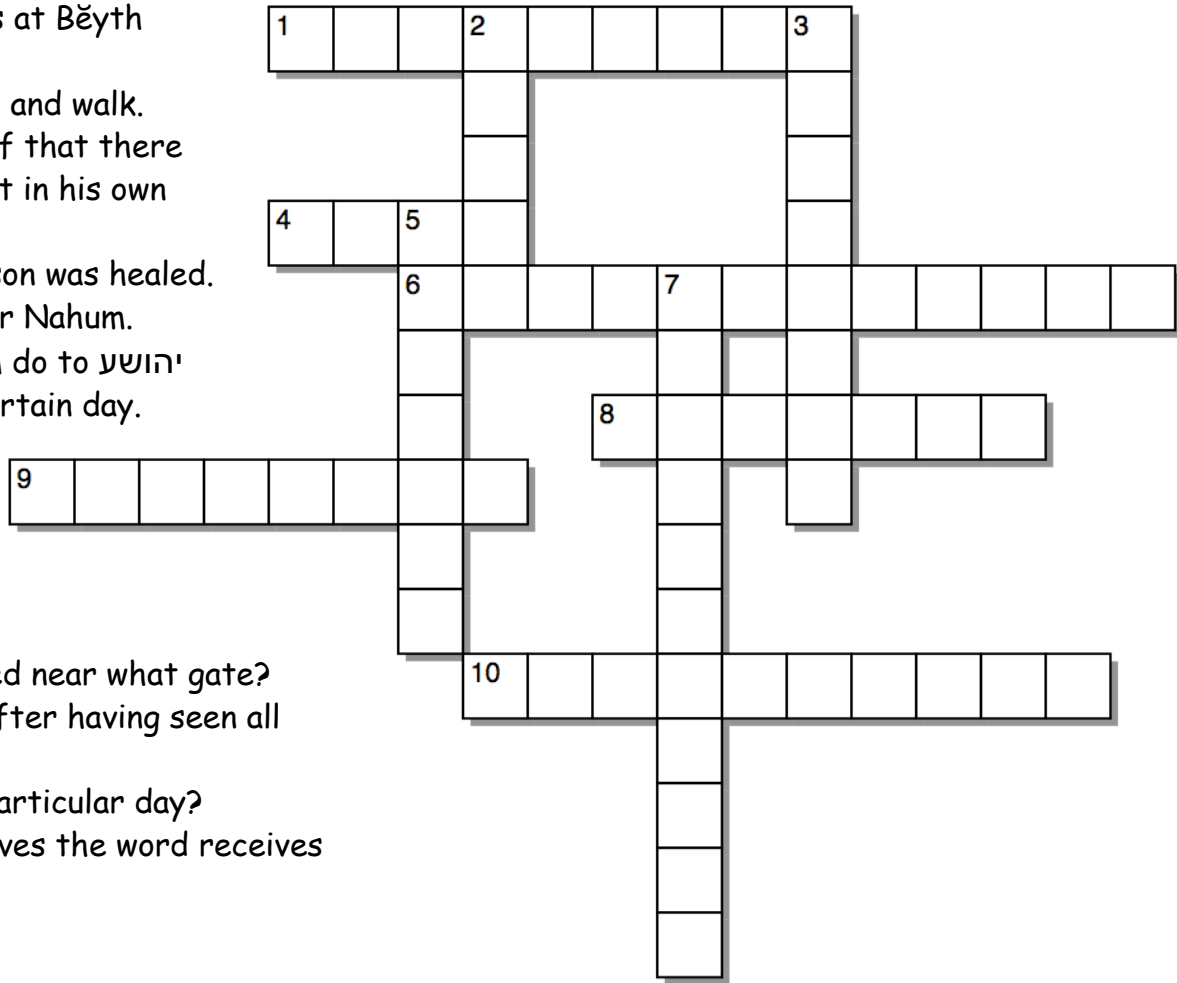
