

Second Writings Yohanan (John 9:31-10:32)

John 9:31-41

31 And we know that Elohim does not hear sinners. But if anyone fears Elohim and does His desire, He hears him.

32 "From of old it has never been heard that anyone opened the eyes of one who was born blind.

33 "If this One were not from Elohim, He could have done none at all."

34 They answered and said to him, "You were completely born in sins - and are you teaching us?" And they cast him out.

35 יהושע heard that they had cast him out, and when He had found him, He said to him, "Do you believe in the Son of Elohim?"

36 He answered and said, "Who is He, Master, that I might believe in Him?"

37 And יהושע said to him, "You have both seen Him and He who speaks with you is He."

38 And he said, "Master, I believe," and bowed before Him.

39 And יהושע said, "For judgment I have come into this world, that those not seeing might see, and those seeing might become blind."

40 And those of the Pharisees who were with Him heard these words, and said to Him, "Are we blind, too?"

41 יהושע said to them, "If you were blind, you would have no sin, but now you say, 'We see,' therefore your sin remains.

John 10:1-32

1 "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter through the door into the sheepfold, but climbs up by another way, that one is a thief and a robber.

2 "But he who enters through the door is the shepherd of the sheep.

3 "The doorkeeper opens for him, and the sheep hear his voice. And he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.

4 "And when he has brought out his own sheep, he goes before them. And the sheep follow him, because they know his voice.

5 "And they shall by no means follow a stranger, but shall flee from him, because they do not know the voice of strangers."

6 יהושע used this figure of speech, but they did not know what He had been saying to them.

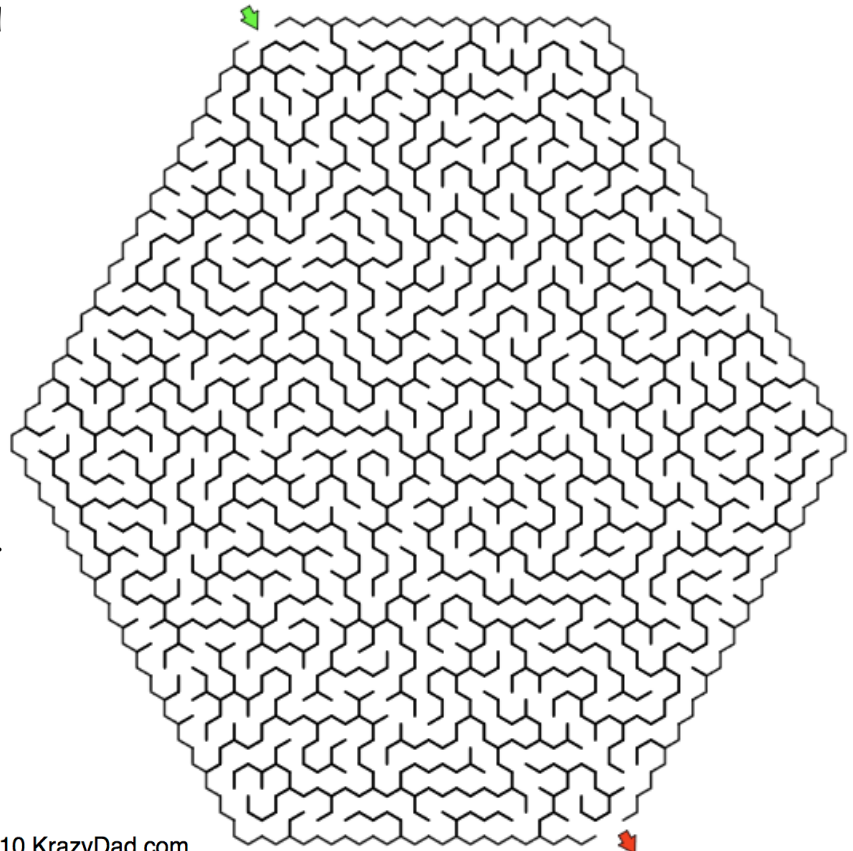
7 יהושע therefore said to them again, "Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep.

8 "All who came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them.

9 "I am the door. Whoever enters through Me, he shall be saved, and shall go in and shall go out and find pasture.

10 "The thief does not come except to steal, and to slaughter, and to destroy. I have come that they might possess life, and that they might possess it beyond measure.

11 "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.
12 "But the hireling, and not being a shepherd, one who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees. And the wolf snatches the sheep and scatters them.
13 "Now the hireling flees because he is a hireling and is not concerned about the sheep.
14 "I am the good shepherd. And I know Mine, and Mine know Me,
15 even as the Father knows Me, and I know the Father. And I lay down My life for the sheep.
16 "And other sheep I have which are not of this fold - I have to bring them as well, and they shall hear My voice, and there shall be one flock, one shepherd.
17 "Because of this the Father loves Me, because I lay down My life, in order to receive it again.
18 "No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to receive it again. This command I have received from My Father."
19 Again there came a division among the Yehudim because of these words,
20 and many of them said, "He has a demon and is mad, why do you listen to Him?"
21 Others said, "These are not the words of one possessed by a demon. Is a demon able to open the eyes of the blind?"
22 At that time the Hanukkah, came to be in Yerushalayim, and it was winter.
23 And יהושע was walking in the Set-apart Place, in the porch of Shelomoh.
24 So the Yehudim surrounded Him and said to Him, "How long do You keep us in suspense? If You are the Messiah, say to us plainly."
25 יהושע answered them, "I have told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's Name, they bear witness concerning Me.
26 "But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you.
27 "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.
28 "And I give them everlasting life, and they shall by no means ever perish, and no one shall snatch them out of My hand.
29 "My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all. And no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.
30 "I and My Father are one."
31 Again the Yehudim picked up stones to stone Him.
32 יהושע answered them, "Many good works I have shown you from My Father. Because of which of these works do you stone Me?"

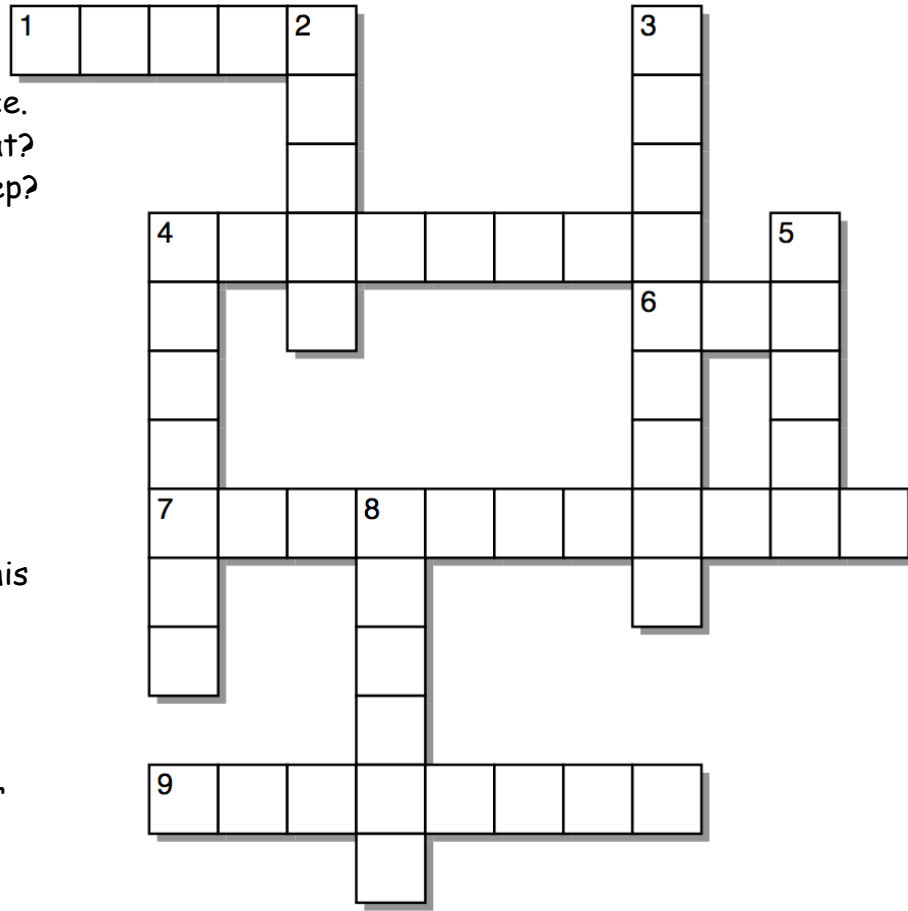
